Rules and Conditions of Entry

Eligibility

The competition is open to all pupils aged 12 – 18 years of age attending a Secondary Institution within the boundary of the City of Glasgow.
All entries must be appropriate to the Competition Brief for 2012.
All entries must be the unaided work of the pupil.

Submissions

Entries are to be submitted to the Glasgow Art Club 185 Bath Street, Glasgow on Tuesday 28th February 2012 between 10.00 am and 1.00 pm. Entries will not be accepted after this time.

Entries may be submitted before this date to the RGI Kelly Gallery, 118 Douglas Street, Glasgow by arrangement with the Curator at email : curator@royalglasgowinstitute.org or by telephone : 0141 248 6386

Prizes and Judging

There will be two age groups, 12 – 14 years and 15 – 18 years.
For each of these groups, a first, second and third prize will be awarded.
An award will be made to the pupil who is judged by the assessors to have submitted the best work of the competition.

Prize List

For each age group

1st Prize : Prize to the value of £60.00 to the Pupil :
£60.00 to School Art Department

2nd Prize : Prize to the value of £50.00 to the Pupil :
£50.00 to School Art Department

3rd Prize : Prize to the value of £40.00 to the Pupil :
£40.00 to School Art Department

The overall winner will receive a commemorative Prize and an award of £100.00 will be made to his/her School Art Department.

All entries will be assessed by a panel of established Artists and a selection from all entries will be exhibited in both the RGI Kelly Gallery and the Glasgow Art Club from Saturday 3rd to Saturday 31st March 2012. There will be an opening preview at both venues at 6pm on Friday 2nd March 2012.

No correspondence will be entered into regarding the results of this competition. The judges' decisions will be final.

Prizewinners and works selected for exhibition

The prizewinners and works selected for the exhibition will be notified to the Schools on Wednesday 29th February 2012.

Works not selected for exhibition

Those works not selected for exhibition will be notified to the Schools on Wednesday 29th February 2012 and must be uplifted from the Kelly Gallery from then until Wednesday 7th March. Works not collected by that time will be disposed of at the discretion of the RGI.

Sales

All exhibited work is to be for sale at a set price of £100. Of this, 50% will be paid to the appropriate school with the balance being divided between the RGI and the Glasgow Art Club.

All unsold works are to be uplifted from the RGI Kelly Gallery prior to 5th April 2012. Works not collected by that time will be disposed of at the discretion of the RGI.

Schools who intend to participate in the competition should inform Lynn Mackenzie, the Curator at the Kelly Gallery **not later than Friday 30th September 2011.**
